FULLY FUNDED SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS LIVING OUTSIDE OF THAILAND

NUMBER OF AWARDS

Up to 2 awards

BENEFITS

- Full tuition fee exemption during the normal 4-year study period (excluding any fee payable to other academic institutions)
- A monthly allowance of 9,000 Thai Baht

CONDITIONS

The awardee must maintain the grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.25 in every semester during their study period at KMITL. In addition, the awardee must also comply with these conditions:

- The awardee's first semester grade point score (GPS) must be at least 3.25
- For all other semesters, the awardee's GPS must be at least 3.00

SELECTION

Selection of the awardees for this scholarship is based on the applicant's academic records, English proficiency scores, extra-curricular activities, and an interview.

REQUIREMENTS

The applicant must fulfill the following requirements:

1. The applicants must hold a nationality other than Thai
2. The applicants must have a current residential address in a country other than Thailand
3. The applicants must meet one of the following mathematical proficiency criteria:
 - 3.1. Have a GPA of all mathematical subjects at the high school levels of more than 80% or 3.5 (for the A – F grading system) **or**
 - 3.2. Achieve the minimum score of one of the following mathematical proficiency tests:

4. Applicants must meet one of the following English proficiency criteria:

- 4.1. Had studied abroad in a school that teaches in English at the high school level or its equivalent levels for more than 2 consecutive years **or**
- 4.2. Achieve the minimum score of one of the following English proficiency tests:

CONDITIONS

The awardee must maintain the grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.25 in every semester during their study period at KMITL. In addition, the awardee must also comply with these conditions:

- The awardee's first semester grade point score (GPS) must be at least 3.25
- For all other semesters, the awardee's GPS must be at least 3.00

SELECTION

Selection of the awardees for this scholarship is based on the applicant's academic records, English proficiency scores, extra-curricular activities, and an interview.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

1. The applicants must meet one of the following mathematical proficiency criteria:
 - 1.1. Have a GPA of all mathematical subjects at the high school levels of more than 80% or 3.5 (for the A – F grading system) **or**
 - 1.2. Achieve the minimum score of one of the following mathematical proficiency tests:
